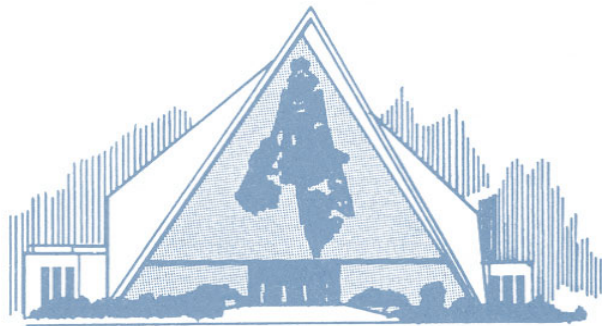
Shrine (1963) + Co-Cathedral Reno/Las Vegas (1976)

Nazareth Boys Town in Mbare, Rwanda, received assistance from Pope Benedict XVI for abandoned orphans who are victims of genocide and civil war. *Casa di accoglienza Giovanni Paolo II Opera Don Orione*, a residence that gives free shelter and specializes in assisting special-needs pilgrims traveling to Rome, was recently refurbished through the Peter's Pence Collection. In Bosnia, the *Hospital of St. Vincent de Paul*, a health institution in Sarajevo staffed by religious, was established with support from the Collection.

Please be generous in the Collection and, in doing so, cast the love of Christ upon the world.

Rachel's Vineyard Retreat for Healing After Abortion

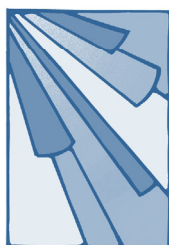
