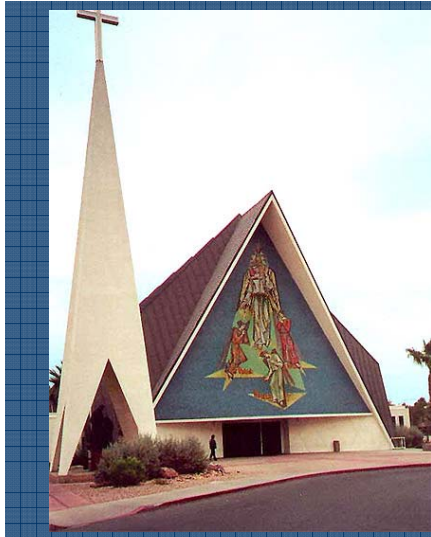

On July 1, 2010 Bishop Pepe appointed two Chaplains to the Shrine of the Most Holy Redeemer. Fr. Clarence Savial and Fr. He has taught English and Scripture in Fiji, Australia, and New Zealand. In our Diocese he has served as a Pastor, Administrator, Associate Pastor and Parochial Vicar at St. Francis de Sales, Holy Family, St. Patrick's in Tonopah, Prince of Peace, Our Lady of Guadalupe in Bunkerville, Mesquite, St. Francis of Assisi and most recently at St. Joseph Husband of Mary.

**Fr. Sabino** holds PhD's in Educational Sciences and Political Science. He has studied in Rome at the Pontifical Salesian University, Bari-Italy-State

University and graduated Summa cum laude at both schools. He has also studied in the US at California State University in San Diego. Fr. Sabino is also the author of several textbooks and articles. In the Diocese of Las Vegas he has served at Prince of Peace, St. Anne's, St. Bridget's, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, and as Hospital Chaplain.

### THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY 8.15.10

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII declared infallibly that the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary was a dogma of the Catholic Faith. Likewise, the Second Vatican Council taught in the Dogmatic Constitution Lumen Gentium that "the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, when her earthly life was over, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things (n. 59)."

## SUMMER SCHOOL FOR CATHEDRAL MINISTRIES

**ALL:** Read the weekly Bulletin & monthly Newsletter. You are expected to be "in the know."

**CANTORS:** Be respectful of the peoples' parts. You need not be singing over the people all the time. Let them hear themselves: that is encouragement enough.

**USHERS:** Prepare/Instruct the Gift Bearers BEFORE Mass NOT DURING the collection. Allow the people to pass the basket to one another. There is no need for you to accept it at the end of each row. Their giving and receiving is an important part of the ritual.

**SERVERS/EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS:** Watch that Hosts are not falling on the floor. Servers – In setting the Table...to place the corporal, find the center of the altar between the cross-slits in the altar cloth or the pin in the center of the altar cloth. EM's – Unless the ciborium is very full (overflowing), there is not need to cover the ciborium with your hand as you proceed to your assigned position.

**LECTORS:** Make certain you know the correct pronunciation of proper names. If you are uncertain, ask. Elijah and Elisha (for example) are different people and their names are pronounced differently. Also, in the Prayers of the Faithful, when you see in red the words "Pause", do so. If there are several "Pauses", wait longer before you complete the petition. Read thoughts not just words. Most of your Readings are stories, instructions or a letter. Proclaim these as such. Not only should the assembly experience two different readers but also two different readings.
